

## **POTATOES 90-120 Days to Maturity**

Plant when ground can be worked. 2-4 weeks before last frost date.

Sunny spot. Well drained soil mixed with plenty of well rotted compost.

Cut potatoes in quarters leaving 2-3 eyes per piece. Cure pieces 2 days in cool dry place.

Plant eyes up in shallow trench 6" deep, 12" apart. Cover with 4" soil.  
Space rows 3' apart

When plants are 4"-6" tall, heap soil around stems. Continue heaping until plants are 12" tall and begin to flower.

Harvest new potatoes after blossoms appear.

Harvest storage potatoes after foliage dies.

Potatoes can stay in the ground up to the first frost

1 potato plant yields 2#-5# potatoes

## **Onions**

Plant in sunny spot 4-6 weeks before last frost date

Plant each set 4"-6" apart pointed end up. Rows 1'-2' apart

Cover with 2" soil

Harvest in fall when tops start to yellow and fall over
